GDPR & International Visitors Notice

Additional information for visitors in the EEA and UK

This Notice supplements our Privacy Policy and applies where the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) or the UK GDPR applies to our processing of your personal data — for example, where you are located in the EEA or UK and buy from, or sell to, Collect DXB. Where this Notice and the Privacy Policy differ for such visitors, this Notice prevails.

01 Controller

“Collect DXB” is the brand and trading style of a Dubai-licensed establishment registered with the Department of Economy and Tourism (DET) under Trader Licence no. 1616389, registered trade name “Collect Luxury Items Online Seller” (in these terms, “Collect DXB”, “we”, “us”, “our”). We source, authenticate and resell vintage and pre-owned luxury goods, including wristwatches, Hermès and other designer handbags and accessories, jewellery and collectibles. 02 Lawful bases (GDPR Article 6)

We process your personal data on one or more of these bases: performance of a contract with you; compliance with a legal obligation (including anti-money-laundering and tax law); your consent (for example, for marketing and non-essential cookies), which you may withdraw at any time; and our legitimate interests in operating, securing and improving our business, balanced against your rights and freedoms.

03 Your rights

Subject to the GDPR, you have the right to: access your data; have it corrected; have it erased; restrict or object to processing; data portability; withdraw consent at any time; and not be subject to solely automated decisions with legal effect. We do not carry out solely automated decision-making that produces legal effects concerning you.

04 International transfers

Collect DXB is based in the UAE, so your data is processed outside the EEA/UK. Where we transfer personal data from the EEA or UK, we rely on an appropriate transfer mechanism, such as Standard Contractual Clauses or an equivalent safeguard, and take steps to ensure your data receives an adequate level of protection.

05 Retention

We keep personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes set out in our Privacy Policy and to meet legal, tax and AML obligations, after which it is securely deleted or anonymised.

06 Complaints

If you are in the EEA or UK you have the right to lodge a complaint with your local data-protection supervisory authority (in the UK, the Information Commissioner's Office). We would, however, appreciate the chance to address your concern first — please contact info@collectdxb.com.
